position summary: The role of the material processor is to work with incoming salvaged building material and prepare it for reuse. The part-time position is 12-18 hours per week and will take place at the Re-use Hawai'i Warehouse at 200 Keawe Street, in Kaka'ako.

work hours: 9am to 4pm, Monday- Friday.

schedule: 2-3 shifts a week, 6 hour shifts per week. Schedule is flexible and can accommodate applicant's schedule, but no "half shifts" available.

position responsibilities:

- Denail lumber, stack, cut, and catalog material
- Daily clean up of work site



required work traits and abilities:

- High proficiency using hand and power tools
- Attention to detail and safety
- Ability to switch tasks quickly and often
- Excellent verbal communication skills
- Willing and able to learn on the job
- Must be responsible, reliable, punctual, honest & efficient



physical requirements:

- Position requires lifting (up to 50 lbs.)
- Individual must have ability to perform intense physical work, including standing, walking, bending, stooping, carrying.

general requirements:

- must have cell phone, internet access, and use email communication
- must have good references
